Not too long ago there was a customer who came into the Ogden DWS office looking for work. He had once been a truck driver, but he explained that he was having trouble getting insulin under his current insurance, which was causing him to fail his DOT physicals. Our community liaison had recently provided our office with information on Seager Memorial Clinic, that included the diabetes clinics offered. I passed on this information to the customer.

He came back a few days later and reported he was able to get insulin from the clinic and that he was feeling so much better as a result. He then scheduled an appointment for another DOT physical and was able to pass. It was not long before he came in and reported he had found new employment driving. None of this would have been possible without the Seager Memorial Clinic's continued service to the community.

We look forward to starting renovations and launching a capital campaign in 2023!

Successes

- 1 We launched our Legacy Donor Program, which builds a sustainable base of individual donors. We have over 30 Legacy Donors thus far!
- We partnered with the Utah Cancer Control Program, Intermountain Healthcare's Mobile Mammography, Weber-Morgan Health Department, and Allen-Taintor Dermatology to provide health screenings for over 80 underserved patients at our 3rd Annual Health Screening Day.
- **3** We partnered with the Essilor Vision Foundation to offer a new Pediatric Eye Clinic each month, giving kids eye exams and glasses at no cost.
- We used Weber-Morgan Health Department's Health Equity Grant to boost our social media presence and revamp our website.
